First National Judicial Pay Commission – Appointment of Senior Civil Judges and Junior Civil Judges to the "Assured Career Progression" Scale I & II – Orders –issued

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ORDER:

In the reference 2nd read above, The Registrar (Vigilance), High Court of Andhra Pradesh, Hyderabad has stated that the First National Judicial Pay Commission constituted by the Government of India in pursuance of the directions of the Supreme Court of India submitted its report on the conditions of the Service and Pay Scale etc. to the Judicial Officers. The Supreme Court of India accepted the recommendations of the First National Judicial Pay Commission. In the G.O.Ms.No.60, Law (LA&J-SC.F) Department, dated 7-5-2003 orders were issued adopting revised pay Scales as recommended by the Commission to the subordinate Judicial Officers, including the Assured Career Progression Scales. The Registrar (Vigilance), High Court of A.P., Hyderabad has requested the Government to issue orders for appointing the Senior Civil Judges and Junior Civil Judges to the Assured Career Progression scales as recommended by the Supreme Court of India.

2. The Government after careful consideration hereby accord sanction for appointment of Civil Judges (Junior Division) and Civil Judges (Senior Division) to the following Assured Career Progression Scales.

Civil Judges (Junior Division):

Assured Career Progression Scale - I

- i) Rs.10750-300-13150-350-14900 in respect of those who have completed 5 years of continuous service from the date of entry.

Assured Career Progression Scale – II

- ii) Rs.12850-300-13150-350-15950-400-17550 in respect of those who have completed another 5 years of continuous service.

Civil Judge (Senior Division):

Assured Career Progression Scale - I

- i) Rs. 14200-350-15950-400-18350 in respect of those who have completed 5 years of continuous service.

Assured Career Progression Scale - II

- ii) Rs. 16750-400-19150-450-20500 in respect of those who have completed another 5 years of continuous service.

3. The Assured Career Progression Scales ordered in para 2 above are subject to following conditions:

- (i) conferment of benefits by way of Assured Career Progression Scheme shall not be automatic but on the appraisal of their work and performance by a Committee of Senior Judges of the High Court constituted for the purpose.
- (ii) the financial up-gradation should not be provided to those who have declined regular promotion on any personal ground.
- (iii) in case where an Officer in the cadre of Civil Judge (Junior Division) or Civil Judge (Senior Division) who has been provided the Assured Career Progression, refuses functional promotion to the higher cadre in his turn of seniority and merit, he shall be reverted to the original pay scale.

4. The Registrar, A.P. High Court is requested to take necessary action.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance (PC.I) Department vide their U.O.No.27423/649/A1/2004, dated 5-11-2004.
