ORDER:-

In the reference cited, the Registrar (Admn.), High Court of A.P., Hyderabad has informed that the First National Judicial Pay Commission has recommended the "Special Pay" for the Judicial Officers and it is one of the several recommendations made by the commission. The Commission at Para 19.147 of Vol.III of the said report has requested the High Court to evolve a principle of paying "Special Pay" to such of those Judicial Officers who have considerable administrative work outside the Court house. The said report has been approved by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in its Judgment dated 21.03.2002 in W.P. (C) No.1022/89.

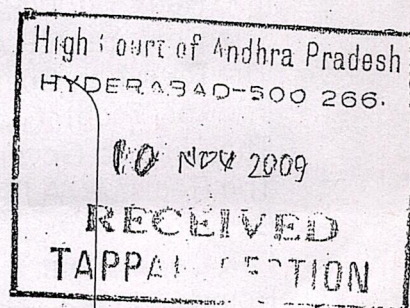
2) The Hon'ble Supreme Court in its order dated 09.09.2008 directed the High Court of A.P. to look into Special Pay issue and send suitable recommendations to the State Government.

3) Accordingly, the Registrar (Admn.), High Court of A.P. proposed for sanction of special pay for such of those identified categories of officers at different rates, duly recommending the Government.

4) Government, after careful examination of the matter, in tune with the recommendations of the First National Judicial Pay Commission, hereby accept the recommendations made by the Registrar (Admn.), High Court of A.P. and accordingly hereby sanction Special Pay to the following Judicial Officers with effect from 1.11.1999 as shown below:-

1) **The Registrars (Five) , High Court of A.P. and the following category of Dist. & Sessions Judges i.e.,**

- All the Prl. & I Addl. District & Sessions Judges working in the State of A.P.
- Judge, Family Courts.
- Special Judges for trial of cases under SCs and STs (POA) Act.
- Chairman of Industrial Tribunals.
- Presiding Officers of Labour Courts.
- Chairman, Co-operative Tribunals.
- Presiding Officers, State Transport Appellate Tribunal, Hyderabad.
- Chairman, Sales.Tax Appellate Tribunals, Hyderabad and Visakhapatnam.
- Presiding Officer, A.P. Wakf Tribunal, Hyderabad.

- 2) All the Prl. Senior Civil Judges : Rs.500/-
3) All the Prl. Junior Civil Judges : Rs.350/-

5) The Special Pay sanctioned in para '4' above shall be paid in cash from 1.1.2009 onwards. The arrears of Special Pay from 1.11.1999 to 31.12.2008 shall be credited to the respective General Provident Fund Accounts of the employees. In respect of those who do not have General Provident Fund Accounts, the arrears shall be credited to the relevant Head of Account to be transferred to the General Provident Fund Account whenever it is opened. However, in the case of employee who ceases to be in service prior to the opening of General Provident Account, the arrears so impounded shall be drawn and paid in cash on the date on which such employee ceased to be in service. The concerned drawing and disbursing officers are directed to credit the arrears to the General Provident Fund Accounts after deducting the income tax payable on the arrears.
